## Menu Selection

## Stay the Night

Our nine award-winning rooms are individually styled and decorated using sumptuous furnishings and fittings, each with surprising and luxurious touches. They are the perfect choice for your wedding night, and for some of your guests.

The Bridal Suites, either The Square Room with views over the cobbled village square, or Number 6 with its fantastic chandelier, are reserved for you as part of your wedding package, and your guests might enjoy the glamour of Number 10, or the tranquillity of the White Room.

All rooms have Fairtrade coffees and teas, bottled mineral water, Sedbergh Soap Co toiletries, and waffle bathrobes.

Please see our current brochure or our website for room rates. All rooms will be provisionally held for three months from the time of booking and a 50% deposit is required to secure each room reservation.

The cancellation policy for room reservations is a full refund up to 14 days before your arrival date. If you cancel within 14 days and we can re-sell the room, you will receive a full refund of your deposit.

If we cannot sell the room, we will not refund the deposit.

Check-in time: from 2.30pm on the day of arrival

Check-out time: 11.00am.



## What Happens Next.....

Following your viewing of the house, a date can be provisionally held for a maximum of four weeks. This will allow the opportunity for you to check the availability of the Church or Registrar. After this time, the date should either be confirmed or released

To confirm your wedding date, we request a non-refundable deposit of £1,000

The Civil Ceremony Charge is £300.00

Our exclusivity charge is £1500 to £2500.00 depending on which day you are getting married

A copy of the terms and conditions will be forwarded to you for completion with the deposit confirmation.



## Payment

Once the £1,000 deposit is settled, there is no further payment required until four weeks prior to your wedding day, when 85% of the total cost should be paid. Final numbers are taken four days prior to your wedding day, and the final amount can be settled on departure.

Payment can be made either by BACS, cash or by debit card. We are unable to accept credit card payments for wedding accounts.

You will have regular communication and updates in the lead up to your wedding, ensuring you approve the menu and drinks, together with your final number of guests.
