| 7 | Pol Roger Brut Réserve NV, Epernay<br>An appealing and complex nose of delicate white flowers, green apples and brioche. Stone fruit flavours on the palate with hints of nuttiness and honey.  |          | £65.00 |
| 8 | Bollinger Rosé NV, Aÿ<br>Dry, powerful and very serious indeed, this highly polished rosé combines notes of plum, patisserie, cinnamon and spice. | 9 | Pol Roger Vintage 2008, Epernay<br>An attractive deep golden colour with a continuous thread of lingering bubbles. | 10 | Chenin Blanc, Simonsvlei, Western Cape, South Africa<br>Ripe tropical fruit aromas, especially guava and pineapple, complemented by hints of lemon. Good balance of fruit and acidity, followed by a fresh, zesty finish.  | £3.75/£5.25/£7.45 | £21.50 |
| 11 | Chardonnay Reserve St Marc, Languedoc, France<br>Excellent Chardonnay from the south of France. Iconic of the style, with lots of stone fruit flavours and an underlying mineral quality. Dry and delicious.   | £3.75/£5.25/£7.45 | £21.50 |
| 12 | Pinot Grigio, Naonis, Veneto, Italy<br>A lovely floral aroma, with masses of fresh fruit flavours on the palate and a rush of crisp citrus acidity, making it perfectly balanced and totally refreshing.   | £4.50/£5.95/£8.50 | £22.95 |
| 13 | Sauvignon Blanc, Visitors, Marlborough, New Zealand<br>An intense wine packed with passionfruit, mangoes and lychees. This glass would be overpowering if it were not balanced beautifully by an acidity that presents lemon and lime notes through to a zesty finish. | £4.85/£6.00/£9.70 | £24.50 |
| 14 | Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine Langaran, Languedoc, France<br>Gentle and refreshing with notes of Mediterranean white peach, apricot kernel and zesty lime peel culminating in a silky mouth-feel and crisp, vibrant acidity.   |                   | £26.50 |
| 15 | Albariño, Cazazul, Rias Baixas, Spain<br>Intense fruit flavours highlighting pear, apple and peach, balanced by the smoothness of stone fruit. Well balanced, finishing fresh and clean.   |                   | £29.95 |
| 16 | Gewürztraminer Reserve, Cave Hunawehr, Alsace, France<br>The nose is very complex with very delicate perfumes of lychee, mango and particularly rose. Full-bodied, this off dry wine has a refreshing acidity with roses lingering on the long finish.                 |                   | £34.00 |
| 17 | Chardonnay 'Morning Fog', Wente, California, USA<br>Green apple and tropical fruit aromas and flavours. Oak, cinnamon and vanilla hints from oak ageing. Mouth filling body with good, balanced acidity.   |                   | £38.50 |
| 18 | Bacchus, Giffords Hall, Suffolk, England<br>Gooseberry and elderflower notes. Dry but the perfume and depth of fruit make it appear more of a medium dry. It is, quite simply - delicious.   |                   | £38.95 |

## White Wines

- 19 Rioja Blanco, Tobelos, Spain £38.95  
Good intensity of clean ripe citrus fruit, pleasant toasty oak and smoked notes. Dry, light, with balanced fruit and wood assemblage, broadening out on the palate and leaving a lingering refreshing taste of toasty ripe fruit.
- 20 Lugana, Citari, Lombardy, Italy £38.95  
Straw yellow colour with greenish reflections. Delicate hints of fresh fruit, in particular apple, white peach and citrus. The palate is balanced and fresh, elegant and refined, confirming the fruity scents.
- 21 Pouilly Fumé, Domaine du Petit Soumard, Loire, France £39.95  
Smoked aromas and scents of gooseberry and grass. The palate is clean and crisp with notes of white melon, lime and grapefruit.
- 22 Barrel Fermented Torrontes, Susana Balbo, Argentina £42.00  
Pale gold with bright reflections. On the nose, hints of white pear, white flowers and ripe peach. On the palate, it has a beautiful structure and acidity. Plenty of body for a wine that shows such delicate aromas and flavours. Fruity, floral and yet still quite dry.
- 23 Pinot Gris, Holly's Garden, Victoria, Australia £42.85  
A Golden Delicious apple and William pear fruitiness with some ginger spice. Ferrous, robust mineral character, gives this wine incredible length and balance.
- 24 Vouvray, Sébastien Brunet, Loire, France £48.85  
A delicious fruit driven aroma with subtle hints of honey. The palate is much more linear, giving some bright fresh citrus and then some apricots coming out on the end.
- 25 Sancerre 'Les Caillottes' - Domaine Jean Max Roger, Loire, France £55.95  
Elegant dry white wine, bright with the quintessential characteristics of sauvignon Blanc from this region: ripe citrus fruits and fresh, grassy aromas and flavours which finish with a refreshing zippiness.
- 26 Chablis 1er Cru 'Les Fourneaux' - Domaine de Meuliere, Burgundy £59.95  
A cool climate Chablis with good minerality. The vines are sixty years old which gives concentration and a lovely aromatic nose. The palate has a beautiful saline mineral quality and a classic fresh acidity.
- 27 Puligny Montrachet, 'Les Noyers Brets' Jean Marc Pillot, Burgundy, France £89.95  
A wine of great finesse, distinguished and elegant. The aromas evoke trees in bloom and white flesh fruit, like white peaches. On the palate, there is a sensation of fresh silkiness. Long and persistent in the aftertaste, ending on an exceptional wealth of flavours, both floral and fruity.

## Red Wines

- 28 Merlot, Reserve St Marc, Languedoc, France £3.75/£5.25/£7.45 £21.50  
A dark garnet red colour with a fruity nose, mixed with spicy notes of thyme and pepper.
- 29 Montepulciano D'Abruzzo DOC Pasqua, Italy £3.95/£5.55/£7.95 £22.00  
A dark skinned Italian grape that delivers ripe and spicy wines with grip and tight tannins. This presents lovely blackberry and Morello cherry flavours.
- 30 Pinot Noir Reserva, Pacifico Sur, Chile £23.95  
Aromas of cherries and raspberries with soft notes of oak. The palate is smooth with elegant tannins followed by a sophisticated finish.
- 31 Shiraz, Cranswick Estate, Barossa, Australia £26.50  
Berry fruit, plums and spicy mocha chocolate oak aromas on the nose. with savoury stewed cherry and blackcurrant flavours on the palate.
- 32 Malbec, Los Haroldos, Mendoza, Argentina £5.25/£7.25/£10.25 £28.50  
Plum, damson and black cherry fruit aromas. The palate is mid weight with smooth, soft tannins. The finish shows berry fruit and a hint of spice.
- 33 Chianti Colli Senesi, Borghesi, Tuscany, Italy £29.50  
Gentle, fresh, and harmonic thanks to an appropriate balance of alcohol, tannins, and acidity and it persists a long time on the palate.
- 34 Côtes du Rhône, La Famille Perrin, Rhône, France £33.95  
Rich fruity, blackberry aromas. Provence herbs, velvety tannins and a real elegance.
- 35 Fleurie, Montangeron, Beaujolais, France £34.95  
Elegant and velvety in texture with characteristic perfumed aromas of delicate floral notes and ripe red berries. Good weight and depth with soft blackcurrant and subtle violet notes throughout lead to long silky finish.
- 36 Zinfandel, Wente, California, USA £38.50  
Strawberry and dark fruit aromas with hints of cinnamon, vanilla and cherry. Mouth filling dark fruit flavours with spice.

## Red Wines

- 37 Cabernet Franc, Rutini Coleccion, Argentina £42.50  
Intense and elegant. Excellent structure with plenty of concentration of red fruits and peppers. Great balance and aromatic on the nose. Medium to full body.
- 38 Château Maurac Cru Bourgeois, Haut Medoc, Bordeaux £42.50  
A wine blend of two-thirds Merlot with one-third Cabernet Sauvignon. Mature with dried fruit, peppery spice, grilled meat, tobacco and leather flavours on the palate.
- 39 Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Urbina, Rioja, Spain £48.50  
A classic spicy mature Rioja aroma but still with a wealth of fruit. On the palate there is an intensity of stewed autumn fruits, combined with sweet spice. The texture is soft and smooth with a lingering finish. (1999 Vintage)
- 40 Shiraz, Hentley Farm, Barossa, Australia £49.50  
Blackberry, floral notes and a hint of spice. Full bodied, rich and opulent, this wine combines great fruit purity with texture, complexity, finesse and a long finish.
- 41 Max Miles Mossop, Stellenbosch, South Africa £56.50  
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Merlot and Malbec, this Bordeaux blend has aromas of dark cherries, Christmas cake and a hint of roasted fennel bulb and five spices aromas. The palate is full, rich, lingering and dry, packed with flavours of dark cherries, plums, cassis and mulberries. The tannins are firm and dry which offers an exceptionally long finish.
- 42 Amarone Classico DOCG, Lamberti, Veneto, Italy £64.50  
Aromas and flavours of black cherries, chocolate, coffee and raisins, along with a note of almond. Despite a formidable structure, the palate is velvety, spicy and elegant with an extremely long and lingering finish.
- 43 Château Grand Barrail Lamarzelle Figeac, St Emilion Grand Cru Bordeaux, France £67.50  
Complex, concentrated bouquet, with fruity notes and a hint of violet. Silky in texture on the attack, developing concentrated, fleshy character. Well balanced finishing on well-integrated oaky, spicy notes.
- 44 Chambolle Musigny VV, Domaine Stephane Magnien, Burgundy, France £89.95  
Juniper, smoked bacon, jammy black cherries, and spices. A deep, concentrated, plush, broad wine, it slathers the palate with sensual waves of red and black fruits that linger throughout its exceptionally long finish. Medium to full-bodied, harmonious, and intense.

## Rosé Wines

- 45 Pinot Grigio Blush, Vigna Verde, Italy £4.25/£5.65/£7.95 £22.50  
Copper with rosy tinges. This is a fruity, intense wine with full harmonic flavours.
- 46 White Zinfandel Rosé, Discovery Beach, California, USA £4.25/£5.65/£7.95 £22.50  
Fruit flavours which are evident in the ripe watermelon, strawberry and cherry that is experienced on the palate. This wine has a balance of floral character, sweetness and crisp acidity.

## Dessert Wines

- 47 Samos Vin Doux, Greece £4.50 £19.95  
A beautifully balanced dessert wine. Aromas of apricot jam, over-ripe melon and butterscotch candy.
- 48 Château Padouën, Sauternes, Bordeaux, France £8.95 £29.95  
Notes of peach and exotic fruit. Fresh sweetness. Soft and creamy.
- 49 Red Muscadel, Nuy Winery, Worcester, South Africa £4.00 £33.55  
Typical raisin flavours and distinctive muscat aromas. Great with chocolate desserts and cheeses.

## Port

- 50 Niepoort Ruby Dum £4.00 £23.15  
Dark fruit aromas which follow through on the palate. A youthful wine with great balance.
- 51 Niepoort Tawny Dee £4.00 £23.15  
Delicate nutty aromas and a hint of dried fruit. The palate is very well balanced with a fruity, luscious character, which intergrates well with a long spirity finish.
- 52 Graham's Malvedos £38.85  
Jammy blackberry and blueberry scents, combined with seductive floral hints. The palate is packed with solid, structured, rich and intense black fruit flavours, showing impressive intensity and sweetness leading to a very long lingering finish.
