| 13 | Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine Langaran, Languedoc, France<br>Gentle and refreshing with notes of Mediterranean white peach, apricot kernel and zesty lime peel culminating in a silky mouth-feel and crisp, vibrant acidity.   |                    | £33.95  |
| 14 | Albariño, Taranis, Rias Baixas, Spain<br>High intensity, very fruity and floral. Clean, silky, and powerful dry wine with a well-integrated acidity. It has a good structure and oiliness.   |                    | £35.95  |
| 15 | Sauvignon Blanc-Semillon, Moss Bros, Australia<br>Juicy palate, passionfruit, and citrus on the palate with subtle cut grass and delicate lemon blossom notes, well integrated natural acid with a crisp mineral finish.   |                    | £38.00  |
| 16 | Unoaked Chardonnay, Chamonix, South Africa<br>Intense aroma that recalls ripe apples, lime, and pears with hints of herbs and tropical fruit. ## White Wines

- 18 Riesling (Dry), Cave Springs, Niagra, Canada £44.50  
Nose Aromas of lemon drop, cut grass with ruby grapefruit with undertones of tangerine, anise and fresh pastry. Palate of Key lime, with a delicate yet persistent finish of white peach, dried apricot and lemon grass.
- 19 Rioja Blanco, Tobelos, Spain £46.50  
Good intensity of clean ripe citrus fruit, pleasant toasty oak and smoked notes. Dry, light, with balanced fruit and wood assemblage, broadening out on the palate and leaving a lingering refreshing taste of toasty ripe fruit.
- 20 Bacchus, Lyme Bay, Devon, England £49.00  
This fresh and zesty wine is intensely aromatic with tropicality, minerality and characteristic English hedgerow notes. Best served lightly chilled.
- 21 Pouilly Fumé, Domaine du Petit Soumard, Loire, France £53.95  
Smoked aromas and scents of gooseberry and grass. The palate is clean and crisp with notes of white melon, lime and grapefruit.
- 22 Chardonnay, Liberty School, Hope Family, Central Coast, USA £64.00  
Fresh aromas of lemon peel and pear are accented by notes of caramel that add a touch of richness. Bright stone fruit flavours of apricot and nectarine are balanced with a splash of citrus and creamy vanilla undertones.
- 23 Chablis 1er Cru 'Mont de Milieu' - Domaine de Meuliere, Burgundy, France £76.00  
A cool climate Chablis with good minerality. The vines are sixty years old which gives concentration and a lovely aromatic nose. The palate has a beautiful saline mineral quality and a classic fresh acidity.
- 24 Puligny Montrachet, 'Les Noyers Bret' Jean-Marc Pillot, Burgundy, France £119.00  
A dress sewn with gold, shiny and haloed with greenish reflections. Its bouquet combines hawthorn, almond paste, hazelnut, green apple. The lactic aromas of butter, hot croissant and minerals are usual, as well as honey.

Vibrant fresh red fruit aromas alongside ripe citrus. Well-balanced with a soft finish.
- 26 White Zinfandel Rosé, California, USA £4.95/£6.55/£9.85 £25.95  
Ripe watermelon, strawberry and cherry that on the palate. Sweet and crisp acidity.
- 27 Provence Rosé, Pierre de Taille, France £34.95  
Fresh and fruity bouquet of red fruit and slight citrus mineral note.

| 30 | Shiraz, Third Generation, Australia<br>Lifted aromas of red berry with spice, ash and earthy overtones on the nose. A well structured medium bodied wine displaying ripe fruit, spicy tannins and black pepper nuances.  |                    | £29.95 |
| 31 | Chianti Colli Senesi, Borghesi, Tuscany, Italy<br>Gentle, fresh, and harmonic thanks to an appropriate balance of alcohol, tannins, and acidity and it persists a long time on the palate.   |                    | £37.50 |
| 32 | Côtes du Rhône, Domaine de Magalanne, Rhône, France<br>Rich fruity, blackberry aromas. Provence herbs, velvety tannins and a real elegance.  |                    | £37.50 |
| 33 | Malbec, Los Haroldos, Mendoza, Argentina<br>Plum, damson and black cherry fruit aromas. The palate is mid weight with smooth, soft tannins. The finish shows berry fruit and a hint of spice.  | £6.75/£9.25/£12.95 | £38.50 |
| 34 | Musar Jeune, Chateau Musar, Lebanon<br>Juicy, sweet summer fruits; raspberries, black cherries with hints of elderberry and hibiscus dominate the palate which is beautifully balanced with soft tannins and fresh underlying acidity.                                   |                    | £39.95 |
| 35 | Fleurie, Montangeron, Beaujolais, France<br>Elegant and velvety in texture with characteristic perfumed aromas of delicate floral notes and ripe red berries. | 36 | Zinfandel, Wente, California, USA<br>Strawberry and dark fruit aromas with hints of cinnamon, vanilla and cherry. Mouth filling dark fruit flavours with spice.  |                    | £46.50 |

## Red Wines

- 37 Rioja Crianza Seleccion, Bodegas Urbina, Rioja, Spain £54.50  
A classic spicy mature Rioja aroma but still with a wealth of fruit. On the palate there is an intensity of stewed autumn fruits, combined with sweet spice. The texture is soft and smooth with a lingering finish. (2000 Vintage)
- 38 Black Nose Red, Les Domaines Rouvinez, Switzerland £58.50  
The nose of blackcurrants and well-ripened strawberries is heightened by a scent of fine, smoky spices. On the palate, it is a rich and concentrated wine that keeps the fineness of its aromas. The finish is long and smooth.
- 39 Clos Laborie, Margaux, Bordeaux, France £69.50  
Notes of black fruits and cooked blackcurrant, with hints of roasted coffee or liquorice. Aromas on the nose suggest black fruits and vanilla, producing a full bodied flavour.
- 40 Petit Verdot, 'Winemakers Series' Hermandad, Mendoza, Argentina £72.00  
Complex nose with notes of nut kernel, dark chocolate tinged-black fruits, cinnamon and mocha. A structured, dark and densely fruited palate offers a little herbal lift with grainy tannins on the finish, which is long and resonant.
- 41 Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir) 'Gipskeuper', Klumpp, Germany £72.00  
Lots of berries in the nose as well as on the palate - mostly blackberries, dark ripe cherries and cassis. Herbal notes are accompanied by a smooth minerality and a fantastic melt. Long intense finish.
- 42 Amarone della Valpolicella, Coste Bianche, Tenute Fiorebelli, Italy £85.00  
Complex nose with raisins and violets. The palate is full of rich flavours of herbs, spices, forest fruits and berries.
- 43 Gevrey-Chambertin, Domaine Hermand-Geoffroy, Burgundy, France £120.00  
A more layered if still somewhat fruity nose combines notes of herbal tea, forest floor, red currant and soft wood influence. The mouthfeel of the barely middle weight flavors is finer if not necessarily more concentrated, all wrapped in a mildly austere and tender finish.

## Dessert Wines

- 44 Samos Vin Doux, Greece      £6.95      £25.95  
A beautifully balanced dessert wine. Aromas of apricot jam, over-ripe melon and butterscotch candy.
- 45 Le Tertre Du Bosquet, Sauternes, Bordeaux, France      £8.95      £35.50  
Beautiful golden-yellow straw colour. The nose is intense and complex with roasted nuts and floral notes like acacia. It is ample and unctuous in the mouth with dried apricots, fig and honey.
- 46 Verdejo la Chalada, Semi-Dulce, Vinos Sanz, Spain      £3.95      £32.00  
Intense nose of good power with sweet notes. It presents aromas of ripe white fruit, pineapple and more slightly green apple skin. Great acidity, sugar and alcohol balance.
- 47 Red Muscadel, Nuy Winery, Worcester, South Africa      £6.95      £38.50  
Typical raisin flavours and distinctive muscat aromas. Great with chocolate desserts and cheeses.

- 48 Graham's Fine Ruby      £4.50      £41.95  
Ruby colour, packed with ripe red and black fruit aromas, on the palate luscious black cherry flavours, with excellent balance and an intense finish.
- 49 Graham's 10 Year Old Tawny      £5.50      £66.00  
Complex aromas combined with hints of honey and figs. On the palate, rich mature fruit flavours, beautifully mellowed with a luscious and long finish.
- 50 Graham's Malvedos      £8.50      £51.50  
Jammy blackberry and blueberry scents, combined with seductive floral hints. The palate is packed with solid, structured, rich and intense black fruit flavours, showing impressive intensity and sweetness leading to a very long lingering finish.
