| 7 | Pol Roger Brut Réserve NV, Epernay
An appealing and complex nose of delicate white flowers, green apples and brioche. Stone fruit flavours on the palate with hints of nuttiness and honey. | | £75.00 |

Dry, powerful and very serious indeed, this highly polished rosé combines notes of plum, patisserie, cinnamon and spice. With structure and weight and harmony of vibrant flavours right across the palate, this is a delicious accompaniment that can match a variety of dishes. | | £90.00 |

| 10 | Chenin Blanc, Simonsvlei, Western Cape, South Africa
Ripe tropical fruit aromas, especially guava and pineapple, complemented by hints of lemon. Good balance of fruit and acidity, followed by a fresh, zesty finish. | £4.25/£5.65/£7.95 | £22.50 |
| 11 | Chardonnay, St Auriol, Pays D'OC, France
Beautiful golden hue. Pleasant nose of tropical fruits and gingerbread. The palate is ample, lively and complex. The wine exudes notes of pineapple, grapefruit, fennel and liquorice. | £4.25/£5.65/£7.95 | £22.50 |
| 12 | Pinot Grigio, Il Caggio, Veneto, Italy
A lovely floral aroma, with masses of fresh fruit flavours on the palate and a rush of crisp citrus acidity, making it perfectly balanced and totally refreshing. | £4.25/£5.65/£7.95 | £22.50 |
| 13 | Sauvignon Blanc, Blason, Loire, France
Bright and grassy, crisp apple on the palate is supported by a good acidity and freshness. Eldeflower on the back end too. This is a great alternative to New Zealand Sauvignon. | £4.95/£6.75/£9.70 | £27.50 |
| 14 | Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine Langaran, Languedoc, France
Gentle and refreshing with notes of Mediterranean white peach, apricot kernel and zesty lime peel culminating in a silky mouth-feel and crisp, vibrant acidity. | | £29.95 |
| 15 | Albariño, Cazazul, Rias Baixas, Spain
Intense fruit flavours highlighting pear, apple and peach, balanced by the smoothness of stone fruit. Well balanced, finishing fresh and clean. | | £30.95 |
| 16 | Gavi del Comune di Gavi, La Smilla, Piedmont, Italy
Fresh and pleasant as soon as it is bottled, it reaches its best expression later in spring. Very flowery with aromas of acacia, peach and apple; full and persistent on the palate with hints of almond. | | £38.50 |
| 17 | Chardonnay 'Morning Fog', Wente, California, USA
Green apple and tropical fruit aromas and flavours. Oak, cinnamon and vanilla hints from oak ageing. Mouth filling body with good, balanced acidity. | | £39.95 |
| 18 | Sauvignon Blanc, Little Beauty, Marlborough, New Zealand
Aromas of honeydew melon, lemon grass and capsicum with a smoky, mineral character. Refreshing on the palate with citrus notes beautifully balanced by flavours of pink grapefruit and basil with a zesty finish. Produced by a former winemaker at Cloudy Bay! | | £39.95 |

- 19 Rioja Blanco, Tobelos, Spain £40.50
Good intensity of clean ripe citrus fruit, pleasant toasty oak and smoked notes. Dry, light, with balanced fruit and wood assemblage, broadening out on the palate and leaving a lingering refreshing taste of toasty ripe fruit.
- 20 Bacchus, Giffords Hall, Suffolk, England £42.00
Gooseberry and elderflower notes. Dry but the perfume and depth of fruit make it appear more of a medium dry. It is, quite simply - delicious.
- 21 Pouilly Fumé, Domaine du Petit Soumard, Loire, France £44.00
Smoked aromas and scents of gooseberry and grass. The palate is clean and crisp with notes of white melon, lime and grapefruit.
- 22 Sancerre - Domaine Laetitia Ducroux , Loire, France £48.50
Crisp and clean with fantastic purity of flavour and elegant mineral tones throughout. Bursting with ripe citrus fruit and supported by a core of zippy acidity. A long, lingering finish.
- 23 Vouvray, Sébastien Brunet, Loire, France £49.95
A delicious fruit driven aroma with subtle hints of honey. The palate is much more linear, giving some bright fresh citrus and then some apricots coming out on the end.
- 24 Chablis 1er Cru 'Les Fourneaux' - Domaine de Meuliere, Burgundy £59.95
A cool climate Chablis with good minerality. The vines are sixty years old which gives concentration and a lovely aromatic nose. The palate has a beautiful saline mineral quality and a classic fresh acidity.
- 25 Puligny Montrachet, 'Les Charmes' Raymond Dupont-Fahn, Burgundy, France £98.50
A dress sewn with gold, shiny and haloed with greenish reflections. Its bouquet combines hawthorn, almond paste, hazelnut, green apple. The lactic aromas of butter, hot croissant and minerals are usual, as well as honey.

Rosé Wines

- 26 Pinot Grigio Blush, Serenissima, Italy £4.25/£5.65/£7.95 £22.50
Vibrant fresh red fruit aromas alongside ripe citrus. Well-balanced with a soft finish.
- 27 White Zinfandel Rosé, California, USA £4.25/£5.65/£7.95 £22.50
Ripe watermelon, strawberry and cherry that on the palate. Sweet and crisp acidity.
- 28 Provence Rosé, Pierre de Taille, France £29.95
Fresh and fruity bouquet of red fruit and slight citrus mineral note.

Red Wines

- 29 Merlot, St Auriol, Pays D'OC, France £4.25/£5.65/£7.95 £22.50
The nose is profound and intense, showing notes of black fruits, sweet spices and liquorice. The palate is full-bodied and intense with notes of blackberries, candied liquorice and cinnamon.
- 30 Pinot Noir Reserva, Pacifico Sur, Chile £4.50/£6.25/£8.95 £23.95
Aromas of cherries and raspberries with soft notes of oak. The palate is smooth with elegant tannins followed by a sophisticated finish.
- 31 Shiraz, Third Generation, Australia £29.50
Lifted aromas of red berry with spice, ash and earthy overtones on the nose. A well structured medium bodied wine displaying ripe fruit, spicy tannins and black pepper nuances.
- 32 Chianti Colli Senesi, Borghesi, Tuscany, Italy £31.50
Gentle, fresh, and harmonic thanks to an appropriate balance of alcohol, tannins, and acidity and it persists a long time on the palate.
- 33 Côtes du Rhône, Domaine de Magalanne, Rhône, France £31.50
Rich fruity, blackberry aromas. Provence herbs, velvety tannins and a real elegance.
- 34 Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina £5.75/£7.95/£10.95 £32.50
Plum, damson and black cherry fruit aromas. The palate is mid weight with smooth, soft tannins. The finish shows berry fruit and a hint of spice.
- 35 Fleurie, Montangeron, Beaujolais, France £39.95
Elegant and velvety in texture with characteristic perfumed aromas of delicate floral notes and ripe red berries. Good weight and depth with soft blackcurrant and subtle violet notes throughout lead to long silky finish.
- 36 Zinfandel, Wente, California, USA £40.50
Strawberry and dark fruit aromas with hints of cinnamon, vanilla and cherry. Mouth filling dark fruit flavours with spice.

Red Wines

- 37 Cabernet Franc, Hermandad, Mendoza, Argentina £48.50
Intense red colour with ruby nuances. Aromas and flavours of black fruits and sweet spices, good volume with silky and structured tannins leading to a persistent and complex finish.
- 38 Clos Laborie, Margaux, Bordeaux, France £49.50
Notes of black fruits and cooked blackcurrant, with hints of roasted coffee or liquorice. Aromas on the nose suggest black fruits and vanilla, producing a full bodied flavour.
- 39 Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Urbina, Rioja, Spain £52.50
A classic spicy mature Rioja aroma but still with a wealth of fruit. On the palate there is an intensity of stewed autumn fruits, combined with sweet spice. The texture is soft and smooth with a lingering finish. (2000 Vintage)
- 40 Woodcutter's Shiraz, Torbreck, Barossa, Australia £49.50
Blackberry, floral notes and a hint of spice. Full bodied, rich and opulent, this wine combines great fruit purity with texture, complexity, finesse and a long finish.
- 41 Max Miles Mossop, Stellenbosch, South Africa £56.50
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Merlot and Malbec, this Bordeaux blend has aromas of dark cherries, Christmas cake and a hint of roasted fennel bulb and five spices aromas. The palate is full, rich, lingering and dry, packed with flavours of dark cherries, plums, cassis and mulberries. The tannins are firm and dry which offers an exceptionally long finish.
- 42 Amarone della Valpolicella, Coste Bianche, Tenute Fiorebelli, Italy £64.50
Complex nose with raisins and violets. The palate is full of rich flavours of herbs, spices, forest fruits and berries.
- 43 Lady Laroze, St Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France £67.50
The nose is very fresh and pure, dominated by Cabernet Franc that emits fresh aromas of liquorice, mint and spices. On the mouth, the attack is fresh and attractive. It has a lot of charm and character, aromatic power with soft tannins that offer a great volume.
- 44 Gevrey-Chambertin, Domaine Hermand-Geoffroy, Burgundy, France £95.00
A more layered if still somewhat fruity nose combines notes of herbal tea, forest floor, red currant and soft wood influence. The mouthfeel of the barely middle weight flavors is finer if not necessarily more concentrated, all wrapped in a mildly austere and tender finish.

Dessert Wines

- 45 Samos Vin Doux, Greece £4.95 £23.95
A beautifully balanced dessert wine. Aromas of apricot jam, over-ripe melon and butterscotch candy.
- 46 La Perle d'Arche, Sauternes, Bordeaux, France £8.95 £35.00
A rich, concentrated and golden-coloured Sauternes. Notes of honey, dried apricots and almonds with some tangy acidity for balance.
- 47 Red Muscadel, Nuy Winery, Worcester, South Africa £4.50 £37.50
Typical raisin flavours and distinctive muscat aromas. Great with chocolate desserts and cheeses.

- 48 Niepoort Ruby Dum £4.00 £24.95
Dark fruit aromas which follow through on the palate. A youthful wine with great balance.
- 49 Niepoort Tawny Dee £4.00 £24.95
Delicate nutty aromas and a hint of dried fruit. The palate is very well balanced with a fruity, luscious character, which intergrates well with a long spirity finish.
- 50 Graham's Malvedos £38.85
Jammy blackberry and blueberry scents, combined with seductive floral hints. The palate is packed with solid, structured, rich and intense black fruit flavours, showing impressive intensity and sweetness leading to a very long lingering finish.
